Right now, our local Church partners, who have worked with affected communities for many years, are providing urgent, practical help to families in Gaza, and now Lebanon.

The situation is such that the Disasters Emergency Committee (DEC) has launched an [emergency appeal](#) and this is the reason I am writing to you now. As a member of the DEC we join our efforts in times like these and ask for compassion, donations and prayers.

I know I am writing to you soon after Family Fast Day, but our Caritas and Church partners in Lebanon, Gaza and the wider region are best placed to actively respond with water, food and shelter for families who have lost so much.
